INDRUM 2024 Grants

The organisation of INDRUM2024 is happy to announce that we are able to offer 10 grants to participants from non-affluent countries.

These grants cover:

- Registration fees.
- Accommodation on campus, in a 2-person shared apartment.

Applicants need to fill the following criteria:

- Be members (faculty, research students) of a university in a country in the OECD list of low income countries (<u>DAC-List-of-ODA-Recipients-for-reporting-2022-23-</u> <u>flows.pdf (oecd.org)</u>).
- Be the presenting author of a paper or poster submission accepted for presentation during the conference.
- Prepare a brief statement (maximum, one page) outlining the reasons that the support is needed.
- For research students (Masters, PhD), a letter from the supervisor confirming the lack of financial support for students from the home institution.

Applicants must submit their contribution (paper or poster proposal), their statement (and the supervisor's statement for students) to the conference chairs (<u>a.gonzalez-martin@umontreal.ca</u> AND <u>ghislaine.gueudet@universite-paris-saclay.fr</u>) before November 23rd, 2023.

Results will be announced by February 17th, 2024.

Please, note that:

- these are valuable, highly sought opportunities for financial support
- we kindly request that grant holders make travel and visa arrangements as early as possible and that they alert the organisers as early as possible if circumstances emerge that do not allow them to participate in the conference. Grant holders are requested to confirm with the organisers by May 1st 2024 their participation in the conference.
- with regret, if a grant is awarded but not taken (and the organisers are not alerted at least a month before the conference) then the applicant will not be able to apply for an INDRUM grant for the next conference.
